A few more guidelines for use of Abundance Acres in case you have questions!

- All fires are to be extinguished prior to leaving the premises. No open fires are allowed except in the designated grill located outside the pavilion and in fire pits by the cabins. Please do not leave the pavilion or cabin areas until any fires are completely extinguished.
- Picnic tables may be moved, but please return them to the pavilion when done.
- Please leave the area clean and free of trash. When leaving, trash may be placed in a dumpster at the entrance of Abundance Acres.
- If you have taped or stapled decorations to the shelter, please remove and dispose of these items.

<u>Electrical Service</u>: The electrical service in the Pavilion is only a 20 amp service, but will support common household equipment. Please no hair dryers or curling irons.
